PENTECOST VIGIL MASS—YEAR A, B, C

First Reading (A): *Genesis 11: 1-9 (Lect. #62)*

“The whole world spoke the same language, using the same words. While the people were migrating in the east, they came upon a valley in the land of Shinar and settled there. They said to one another, ‘Come, let us mold bricks and harden them with fire.’ Then they said, ‘Come, let us build ourselves a city and a tower with its top in the sky, and so make a name for ourselves; otherwise we shall be scattered all over the earth.’

The Lord came down to see the city and tower that the people had built. Then the Lord said: ‘If now, while they are one people, all speaking the same language, they have started to do this, nothing will stop them later from doing whatever they presume to do. Let us then go down there and confuse their language, so that one will not understand what another says.’

Thus the Lord scattered them from there all over the earth, and they stopped building the city.

That is why it was called Babel, because there the Lord confused the speech of all the world.

It was from that place that he scattered them all over the earth.”

PENTECOST VIGIL MASS—YEAR A, B, CFirst Reading (B): *Exodus 19: 3-8a, 16-20b (Lect. #62)*

“Moses went up the mountain to God. Then the Lord called him and said, ‘Thus shall you say to the house of Jacob; tell the Israelites: You have seen for yourselves how I treated the Egyptians and how I bore you up on eagle wings and brought you here to myself. Therefore, if you harken to my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my special possession, dearer to me than all other people, though all the earth is mine. You shall be to me a kingdom of priests, a holy nation. That is what you must tell the Israelites.’ So Moses summoned the elders of the people. When he set before them all that the Lord had ordered him to tell them, the people all answered together, ‘Everything the Lord has said, we will do...’”

PENTECOST VIGIL MASS—YEAR A, B, CFirst Reading (C): *Ezekiel 37: 1-14 (Lectionary #62)*

“The hand of the Lord came upon me, and he led me out in the Spirit of the Lord and set me in the center of the plain, which was now filled with bones. He made me walk among the bones in every direction so that I saw how many they were on the surface of the plain. How dry they were! Then he said to me: ‘Prophesy over these bones, and say to them: Dry bones, hear the word of the Lord.’ Thus says the Lord God to these bones: ‘See! I will bring spirit into you, that you may come to life.

I will put sinews upon you, make flesh grow over you, cover you with skin,
and put spirit in you so that you may come to life and know that I am the Lord...’

Therefore, prophesy and say to them: Thus says the Lord God:

‘O my people, I will open your graves and have you rise from them, and bring you back to Israel.
Then you shall know that I am the Lord, when I open your graves and have you rise from them, O my people!

I will put my spirit in you that you may live, and I will settle you upon your land;
Thus you shall know that I am the Lord. I have promised, and I will do it, says the Lord.”
