Join musicians and pastoral leaders around the country (and around the world!) for a stimulating one-hour webinar—*The Psalms in Christian Worship*—on Thursday, September 9, 2010. The webinar will include a summary of key biblical and theological themes related to the psalms and their use in the Church's worship today, drawing on insights from the history, theology, and pastoral practice of liturgy and preaching. The presentation will also offer practical guidance for musicians, clergy, and other worship leaders in preparing to sing or preach on the Psalms, including the choice of translations available to various denominations.

This one-hour webinar will be presented by Dr. John Witvliet, well-known scholar, teacher, musician, and pastor. Dr. Witvliet is director of the Calvin Institute for Christian Worship and associate professor of music and worship at Calvin College and Calvin Theological Seminary in Grand Rapids, Michigan. He is also the author of several books, including *The Biblical Psalms in Christian Worship*, which has been described as "ecumenical, practical, and passionate."

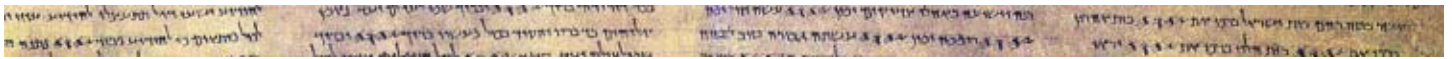
